



ORDINANCE NO. 2005-O-01

AN ORDINANCE TO CONDEMN AN UNSAFE AND DANGEROUS  
BUILDING AT 418 E. FRANKLIN STREET, PALESTINE, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Palestine, Crawford County, Illinois, that it has determined that the garage building situated upon the premises at 418 E. Franklin Street, Palestine, Illinois, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Lot Number 15 in Block 10 in Wabash Addition to the Town, now Village, of Palestine, Illinois.

is unsafe and dangerous and should be either put in a safe condition or demolished; and accordingly said garage building located at 418 E. Franklin Street, Palestine, Crawford County, Illinois, is hereby declared to be unsafe and dangerous and is condemned, all pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, being 65 ILCS 5/11-31-1, et seq.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Village Attorney be directed to commence proceedings under the Unsafe Property Act, as provided for under the laws of the State of Illinois, and to give 30 days written notice by mail to said owners to either place said building in a safe condition or to demolish it and to follow the other procedures as provided by law.
