ORDINANCE NO. 2005-O-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 41, TRAFFIC,  
SECTION 41.19 USE OF COASTERS,  
ROLLER SKATES, AND SIMILAR DEVICES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Palestine, Crawford County, Illinois, that CHAPTER 41, TRAFFIC, Section 41.19 USE OF COASTERS, ROLLER SKATES AND SIMILAR DEVICES of the Palestine Village Code, be, and it is hereby amended to be as follows:

41.19 USE OF COASTERS, ROLLER SKATES AND SIMILAR DEVICES. No person upon roller skates, roller blades, skateboards, or riding in or by means of any coaster, toy vehicle, or similar device shall go upon Main Street from Franklin Street to LaMotte Street, upon Pike Street from Franklin Street to LaMotte Street, upon Franklin Street from Pike Street to Lincoln Street, upon Lincoln Street from Franklin Street to LaMotte Street, and upon LaMotte Street from Pike Street to Lincoln Street, and all streets, alleys and sidewalks bordering and within this area.

Any person filing any provision of this Ordinance or any rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof, shall upon conviction be subject to a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$750.00 and the cost of prosecution.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
