ORDINANCE NO. 2009-O- 02

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE 2000 NATIONAL LIFE
SAFETY CODE AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Palestine, Crawford County, Illinois, has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village and the residents thereof that certain standards exist with regard to construction within said Village; and

WHEREAS, there exists certain standards for construction on a national basis, including the 2000 NATIONAL LIFE SAFETY CODE, AS AMENDED; and

WHEREAS, said code has been revised and amended from time to time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Palestine, Crawford County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. The 2000 NATIONAL LIFE SAFETY CODE, as amended from time to time, is hereby adopted as an Ordinance of the Village of Palestine.

SECTION 2. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance, or any rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof, or any provision of any code adopted herein by reference, shall upon conviction be subject to a fine or not less than \$75, nor more than \$750, and the costs of prosecution.

Any person violating any provision of this code, or any rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof, or any provision of any code adopted herein by reference, shall be subject to the institution of any appropriate action or proceeding (1) to prevent the unlawful construction, reconstruction, alteration, repair, conversion, maintenance or use, (2) to prevent the occupancy of such building, structure or land, or (3) to restrain, correct or abate the violation.

SECTION 3. Each act of violation and each day upon which a violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.

SECTION 4. Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.


SECTION 5. All ordinances and parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
